



REQUEST FOR INFORMATION (RFI)

LANKA GOVERNMENT NETWORK 3 (LGN 3) – SECURE ACCESS FABRIC ALIGNED WITH THE SOVEREIGN GOVERNMENT CLOUD

The Government of Sri Lanka (GoSL), through the **Ministry of Digital Economy (MoDE)**, is advancing its national digital transformation agenda by establishing a unified, secure, and legally recognized digital communication framework across the public sector.

A central enabler of this vision is the **Lanka Government Network 3 (LGN 3)** initiative. This represents a strategic evolution of the existing LGN platform into a cloud-first, policy-driven, and identity-centric secure access fabric. LGN 3 is designed to provide seamless and secure connectivity to government workloads hosted across multiple sovereign cloud regions and approved Cloud Service Provider (CSP) environments.

Objectives of the RFI

This RFI invites technology vendors, network service providers, and system integrators to submit information on modern infrastructure and security solution. The GoSL seeks to gather market insights on:

- WAN, SD-WAN, SASE, and multi-cloud connectivity.
- Zero Trust Network Access (ZTNA), Next-Generation Firewalls (NGFW), and identity-based access models.
- The viability of commodity internet, provider-operated private networks, and mobile broadband (4G/5G).
- Specialized solutions for remote service points and field-level officers (e.g., Grama Niladhari, Midwives) with constrained or intermittent connectivity.
- Indicative CapEx/OpEx models and TCO projections for a nationwide deployment supporting over 1 million users.

Guidelines for Submissions

1. Open to all technology vendors, including those who do not directly provide telecommunications services. Multi-vendor collaborations and consortia are encouraged.
2. Submissions must be clear, structured, and presented in **English**.
